Dear SJA Families,

Archbishop Lori has lifted the dispensation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days due to the progress made in COVID-19 vaccinations and the decline in cases. His attached letter invites and encourages us "to begin attending Mass in person again, confident that at this time, a return to our parish communities is safe for a majority of us."

We will **graduate the 67<sup>th</sup> class** from St. Joan of Arc School tomorrow! Fortunately, we will celebrate a Graduation liturgy followed by a Graduation ceremony at St. Joan of Arc Church at 4PM. This event is truly a celebration at the end of a long and difficult year of restrictions. **Faculty, staff, and parish staff are so proud of the Class of 2021!**

Dear Parent,

I am writing to request your consideration for your child to be an Altar Server at St. Joan of Arc. We have recently received COVID-19 guidance from the Archdiocese that allows us to have Altar Servers at Mass. Although we are at the end of the school year, we want to identify any volunteers who are interested in serving during the summer months.

At SJA, we have a proud tradition of well-trained and dedicated Altar Servers. Serving at the altar is a great privilege and an important ministry for our parish and school. We are seeking boys and girls who will be faithful to this commitment and will take this responsibility seriously.

To be an Altar Server, you should be in the fourth grade or older, and have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation and First Eucharist. We will train children to serve both at the School liturgies on Tuesday and at Masses on the weekends. Altar Server training will be done during the School day.

We hope to resume in-person School Mass in September. For Altar Servers who serve at School liturgies, we coordinate assignments with the class teachers. For Altar Server scheduling on weekends (during the summer), we will coordinate directly with parents via email so that you choose the weekends that you want your child to serve.

# Summer Band Clinic - 2021

What a year it has been! We are excited to share the details of our upcoming summer band clinic. Playing a musical instrument is a year-round activity, and as we continue our path towards in-person instruction, we have developed a plan which will enable us to continue your child's musical development over the summer. Participation is especially important for beginning students.

**FORMAT:** The instruction aspect of the clinic will be an online activity, but we are planning a safe, sociallydistanced in-person concert at the end of summer band. If we are not able to hold an in-person concert due archdiocesan or state rules, then a virtual concert will be held. The clinic will consist of three distinct bands: beginning (those completing their first year), intermediate and advanced; your school band director will determine the level. Summer band instruction will take place over 3 weeks and our 4<sup>th</sup> week will be our dress rehearsals and the concert.

**INSTRUCTION DATES:** The summer clinic will begin on Tuesday, June 29 and will be held three times per week ending Thursday, July 15. **Sessions will be held Tuesday evenings from 6:00 – 9:00 pm; Wednesday afternoons from 1:00 – 4:00 pm; and Thursday mornings from 9:30 am – 12:30 pm.** Each session will be divided into three 45-minute activities: a sectional, band rehearsal, and music theory and games. A short break will be held between each activity. Students can complete all three activities in one day or they may divide them over the three days. The program can be tailored to fit individual family needs, and <u>participants may attend as often as they like --- there is no limit.</u> Note: the Tuesday sessions will be recorded for those students who need to miss that week; student names will not be recorded. Recorded sessions will be available for viewing upon request only; please contact your school band director for the link.

**CONCERT AND DRESS REHEARSAL:** The dress rehearsals and concert will take place <u>outside</u> during the evening hours the week of July 19. We hope to hold a dress rehearsal for each band at a local Catholic elementary school on Monday, July 19 with a rain date of July 20<sup>th</sup>. The time for each band will be posted as soon as possible. The concert will be held Wednesday, July 21<sup>st</sup> with a rain date of Thursday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>. The concert report time and start time will be posted as soon as possible. While it is highly encouraged, participation in the dress rehearsal and concert is not mandatory in order to take part in summer band. In the event we are unable to have an in-person concert, the dress rehearsals and concert will be held virtually.

**FEE and REGISTRATION:** <u>\$112 per child</u>. Access to this program will be available ONLY to families who are registered. There is no limit to the number of sessions your child may attend. Access codes, times for specific levels and materials will be sent to you when we receive your registration form and fee. To guarantee you receive the code, times and materials prior to the start, registration forms and fee must be <u>received in the</u> <u>band office by June 15<sup>th</sup></u>. If you prefer to have the materials mailed to you rather than emailed, please indicate that on your registration form and include an additional fee of \$7.00 to cover the extra expense.

**EQUIPMENT:** To fully participate we ask that everyone have video capability and a device with a microphone, a cell phone or tablet should suffice.
