2020-2020 Archdiocese of Baltimore Income Survey

The Archdiocese of Baltimore will be using a google forms survey to collect family income data for the 2020-21 school year. This safe and secure electronic income survey will automatically collect a family's data as they complete the survey. Collecting family income data is a requirement of MSDE and we must do so annually. The AOB has worked in conjunction with each county in the development of the survey and it meets each county's reporting requirements. The survey takes approximate 2 minutes to complete and must be completed for **each** student. It is **very important** that you do this because it determines the level of funding for all federal and state programs, all of which help to decrease tuition for your family (Safety & Security Grant, Aging Schools Grant, Textbook & Technology funding, Title I, Title IV, and Title II). **2020-21 Income Survey Link: Click here**


